

THE EFFECT OF CHANGES TO THE TAX RATE

The Municipal Tax accounts for 55% of Clive's operating revenue, users fees (water, sewer, garbage) account for 25%, the remaining 20% is a combination of government transfers, franchise fees and other revenue.

The Municipal Tax Rate for 2018 was 8.66 mills. This meant that for every \$1,000 of assessed property value the owner was billed \$8.66. The average home owner in Clive with a property valued at \$250,000 would have been billed \$2,165 for municipal taxes. Note there are also School taxes (2.5 mills) and Lacombe Foundation taxes (0.06 mills) added to the Property Tax bill.

Based on the property assessment within the Village of Clive in order to generate \$10,000 in additional property taxes the tax rate would have to increase by 0.13 mills. An average property assessed at \$250,000 in Clive would pay an additional \$32.50 per year to generate \$10,000 in additional property tax revenue.

In order to maintain the current levels of service and add an additional initiative costing for example \$50,000 per year the average home owner in Clive would notice their municipal tax bill increase by 7.5% equal to an additional \$162.50/year.
