BUILDING INSPECTIONS

The Building Inspector requires inspections of all houses when all the requirements have been completed at each of the three (3) stages listed below:

1. Foundation

- must be dampproofed
- installation of weeping tile and washed gravel
- forward a copy of Engineer's Inspection Report for preserved wood foundations

2. Framing

- framing complete including floors, walls and roof
- roof covering installed (shingles, shakes, concrete tiles)
- exterior doors and windows installed
- fireplaces roughed in and framed
- interior stairs installed where possible
- rough plumbing, electrical and mechanical

3. Final

- inspection required before occupying or using the building
- general and fire safety requirements in the Alberta Building Code must be met at this stage. (e.g. smoke alarms, handrails, guards, self-closure on garage door, etc.)
- if these requirements can be met in a temporary means, a partial occupancy inspection may be carried out.

The <u>Building Permit card is to be posted</u> on site so that it is visible from the road at all times during construction.

INSPECTION REQUESTS:

THREE (3) DAYS in advance of an inspection, phone (403)346-2533 or Fax (403)347-2533 with the following information supplied: owners name, permit number and legal land description of the site.

INSPECTION REPORTS will be left on the site by the Building Inspector.
