

General Information

- Household waste must be kept separate from other waste products.
- Loads must be delivered so that the waste can be sorted into the appropriate containers
- Loads that can not be easily separated may be refused or subject to additional fees



Satellite Transfer Sites Blackfalds, Spruceville, Bentley, Eckville Alix/Mirror

Due to limited quantitles (less than 499 kg) being accepted at transfer stations, there is no charge for any waste disposed of at these sites.

Accepted Waste:

- Household waste (compactor)
- Wood, metal and dry rubble (only quantities less than 499 kg accepted)
- Batteries, propane tanks, and automotive filters
- Agricultural Chemical containers will be accepted at the following satellite sites:
 - Eckville
 - Alix/Mirror

Prohibited Waste:

- White goods, wood, metal or dry rubble in quantities over 499 kg. This must be transported to the Prentiss site
- Used oil, appliances, liquid paint, carcasses, bio-medical waste, grain, seeds, manure, feed, asbestos, explosives, hot burn barrels, radio-active material, grass clippings, and garden waste
- Any waste that in the judgement of the site operator should be rejected by reason of:
 - Unknown content that may be a hazard
 - Type of material, etc.

Transfer Site Operator Job Dutles

The site operator is there to ensure that all waste is disposed of in the proper place.

Ensuring the safety of the site operators is essential and due to recent staff injuries we have asked them to refrain from assisting the patrons unload.

The operator job duties are to manage the burn pit areas, change bins, direct the public to the proper areas, and keep the site clean.

The site operators have been asked to ensure that:

- 1. White Goods will only be accepted at the Prentiss landfill site.
- Loads over 499 kg (anything over ½ ton load and at the site operator's discretion) must be taken to the Prentiss landfill site.
- 3. Under no circumstance shall site operators be allowed to remove safety pins for the drivers.
- 4. Operators will not assist patrons in unloading of burning barrels.
- 5. Satellite sites will only accept pickup loads of silage plastic to reduce the risk of plugging.
- 6. Patrons will be responsible for opening and closing their own end gates.
