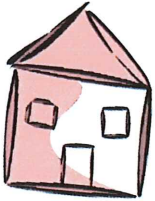

Update: Clive Sustainability Plan



- **Parkland Community Planning Services (PCPS)** was engaged to assist the Village with the creation of a Sustainability Plan. Over the winter months of 2015/2016, PCPS worked with the school and greater community to solicit ideas for the Plan.
- **The Sustainability Planning process identified some areas in the Municipal Development Plan (MDP) and Land Use Bylaw (LUB) that would benefit from updates.**
- The current Land Use Bylaw was passed in 2010 and the Municipal Development Plan was adopted in 2007. These policies and regulations must be kept up to date to ensure that the Village is prepared for the development issues facing the community in the future.

Municipal Development Plan (MDP)
