

# HIGHLIGHTS OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING September 2025

## **Water Consumption Report**

Council was presented with a detailed water consumption report outlining the percentage difference between water received from Highway 12/21 and water used from the residents of Clive.

# By-Lay #572-25: Non-Residential Property Tax Incentive

Council approved the Non-Residential Property Tax By-law #5872-25, allowing new and existing non-residential property tax incentives for new and existing industrial and commercial development undergoing new construction, business revitalization, redevelopment or expansion.

## **Municipal Election 2025**

Council has authorized advance voting for the 2025 Clive Municipal Election.

Advance polls take place on October 9 from 4:00–7:00 p.m. and October 18 from 9:00 a.m.—noon at the Clive Municipal Office (5115 – 50 Street). Six candidates are registered on the election ballot. Election Day is October 20, 2025, from 10:00 a.m.—8:00 p.m. at the Clive Hall (5204 – 50 Street).

# **Capital Plan – Sanitation Repairs**

Council reviewed the Capital Plan Project, which includes repairing sewer lines, replacing manhole covers, and continuing the pavement project. The five-year capital plan remains on schedule. Updated schedule to phase two of the road repaving project will be shared upon approval.

## **Truth and Reconciliation Day**

Council authorized that a photo of council and staff wearing orange shirts be posted on Clive's social media on September 30 to show Clive's recognition of the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. Pause, reflect and honour Survivors, their families, and Indigenous communities the lasting impacts of residential schools. #### 2025 Clive Christmas Gala

Council approved \$1,600 to help lower ticket costs for the 2025 Christmas Gala. This annual event celebrates Clive businesses and gives staff the chance to enjoy a festive Christmas party while networking with others. Tickets for this year's gala cost \$75 per person, reduced from \$100 last year.
