Master Rates and Fees Bylaw#574-26

Council approved the Master Rates and Fees Bylaw# 574-26 establishing the 2026 rates and fees for goods and services delivered in Clive. The updated Master Rates and Fees Bylaw #574-26 is available online at clive.ca.

Clive Fire Response

A motion to amend the Clive Fire Policy increasing fire response rates and fees did not receive the support of council. Current fire suppression response rates remain in effect. Residents and ratepayers will continue to be invoiced for fire calls and motor vehicle accident responses. You are encouraged to contact your insurance company to ensure you have adequate coverage for fire response costs.

Water House Upgrade and Reservoir Feasibility Study

Council approved the Water House Upgrade and Reservoir Feasibility Study and directed Administration to research and apply for grant funding to support the project. The total cost was estimated \$2,383,680 for storage expansion and upgrades to the pumphouse.

Snow Removal Policy

Council reviewed the current snow removal policy and confirmed. Residents are reminded that on weekends and holidays, Public Works operates with minimal staffing unless there is a major snow event or a public works emergency.

Council Inquiries
