Spring Clean-Up & Yellow Compost Bins

Spring is here, please help keep your property clean and tidy. Yellow compost bins are available at four locations for yard waste such as grass clippings, leaves, weeds, garden waste, hedge clippings, small branches up to two feet(2ft), fruit, and needles. **No large branches or large loads in the yellow bin, they must be taken to Prentis for disposal.**

Backyard Recreational Fires – Be Responsible

Backyard recreational fires are allowed in Clive, fire pits and barbecues must be made of non-combustible materials, have a spark arrestor mesh screen, and be supervised by an adult over 18. Only untreated wood, charcoal briquettes, propane, or natural gas may be burned, and flames should not exceed three feet in height. **Remember, there is no burning of leaves, grass clipping, plastic or garbage allowed in your yard at anytime. Please dispose of it properly.**
