



HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE April 13th and 27th, 2026 REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS

April 13th, 2026:

Cemetery Bylaw #576-26

Council passed second and third readings of Cemetery Bylaw #576-26. The bylaw updates the regulations governing cemetery operations in Alberta, ensuring clarity around administration, plot management, and maintenance standards.

Cemetery Operations and Standards Policy #26-01

Council passed the Cemetery Operations and Standards policy. The purpose of this Policy is to establish clear operational standards and technical specifications for cemetery administration, ensuring consistency, safety, dignity, and the long-term sustainability of the Clive Cemetery.

Council Self Evaluation

Council accepted the Council Self-Evaluation Report as information. Once the information is fully aggregated, Mayor Henry will present a summary of the findings for discussion in a Closed Session at the May 11 meeting.

Allocation of 2025 Operating Surplus

Council approved the allocation of the 2025 operating surplus to various reserve accounts, including council projects, legal and administrative needs, fire services, enforcement, roads, water, planning, recreation, and community grants, for a total of \$59,000. These allocations support ongoing operations, future capital needs, and community programs.

2025 Financial Statements

Council reviewed the draft 2025 Financial Statements prepared by auditors Seniuk and Marccato. The report indicated that the Village of Clive has a moderate surplus in its municipal expenditures, assets, and revenues. Council accepted and approved the draft report as presented.

April 27th, 2026

Subdivision Authority Bylaw #576-26

Council unanimously passed all three readings of Subdivision Authority Bylaw No. 576-26, establishing a subdivision authority to carry out subdivision powers and duties.

Request for Crosswalk Placement

Council approved the installation of a crosswalk at 4716 50th Street (Baptist Church), noting it is a well-used informal crossing for preschool students, youth groups, and a school bus stop. Additional signage will be installed, and crosswalk markings will be painted during the June line painting program.

Council Appoints Member to Clive Library Board

Council approved the appointment of Deirdre McLean to the Clive Library Board for a three-year term, effective May 1, 2026 to May 1, 2029.

Summer Parade Schedule

Council reviewed summer parade attendance. All members will attend the Clive Fun Fest Parade on June 20th, 2026. Mayor Henry will also attend the Lacombe Days Parade. Councillor Fahey will attend the Ponoka Stampede Parade. Councillor Russell will attend the Bentley Parade. Councillor Hallman will attend the Penhold Parade. Councillor Nutbrown will attend the Mirror, Eckville, Delburne, and Bashaw parades.



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Emergency Preparedness Week (May 3-9, 2026)

Council directed Administration to coordinate with the Director of Emergency Management to deliver an emergency preparedness social media campaign during Emergency Preparedness Week. Alberta's Emergency Preparedness Week 2026 theme, titled "*In It Together*", is centered around the important preparedness behaviour of making community connections and how it plays a role before, during and after emergencies.

Public Works Week (May 17-23, 2026)

Council designated May 17–23, 2026 as National Public Works Week in the Village of Clive and encouraged residents to recognize the contributions of public works professionals to community health, safety, and quality of life.

Ball Diamond Electrical Project

Council approved funding for the Baseball Diamond electrical project. The project will provide power for a new scoreboard installation and support additional electrical capacity for Christmas lighting used by the Village during the winter season.

Workshops and Conferences

Council authorized Mayor Henry and CAO Kenney to attend the Alberta Municipal Summer Leaders Caucus (MLC) on June 24th, 2026, in Red Deer, Alberta.

LREMP Signing Ceremony

The Lacombe Regional Emergency Management Partnership signing ceremony is scheduled for September 29, 2026. Council authorized Mayor Henry, CAO Kenney, and Fire Chief Zaytsoff to attend the ceremony.
