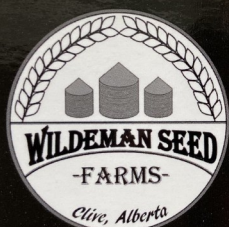

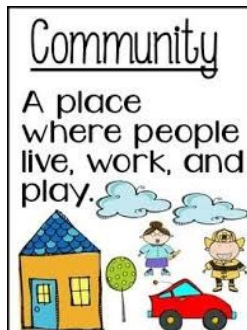

Property Taxes Due August 31 – Avoid Late Penalties

The 2026 Assessment and Property Tax Notices have been mailed. Note that property taxes are **due by August 31, 2026**, to avoid penalties. Clive's notice is a **combined Assessment and Tax Notice**. If you wish to dispute your property assessment, you must file a complaint by **August 14, 2026**. Complaints must be submitted using the required form and must include a **\$50 appeal fee**. Be Prepared – Extreme Weather

Severe weather events like thunderstorms can develop quickly and cause significant damage. They may lead to **wildfires, power outages**, and other dangerous conditions. Thunderstorms often bring **high winds, lightning, heavy rain**, and sometimes **hail, downbursts, or tornadoes**. While most storms last about an hour, more intense **supercell storms** can persist for several hours. Take steps to #BePrepared:

- **Protect your property:** Ensure proper drainage around your home to reduce the risk of basement flooding, secure loose outdoor items, and cover your vehicle to guard against hail damage.
- **Go indoors at the first sound of thunder:** During a hailstorm, stay away from windows, glass doors, and skylights.

Stay informed: Monitor local news and weather updates and be ready to shelter in place if needed.

Every region of Canada is vulnerable to **thunderstorms, lightning, and tornadoes**. Learn more about how to prepare at alberta.ca/know-the-risks.

SHARE the ROAD Golf Cart April 1 to November 30



Golf cart time is coming up. Golf carts are permitted from **April 1 to November 30**, weather permitting. To operate your cart legally, you must have a permit, which costs just **\$60**. Stop by the Village Office to get yours, or apply online at clive.ca/living-in-clive/golf-cart-pilot-project

Trailer Parking – 72 hours max on Village Streets May - Sept

Effective May 1 until October 1st parking of recreation vehicles on residential streets is permitted for a maximum of 72 hours. Note that trailers parked on a residential highway must be attached to a vehicle. The trailer dump station located on 51st Ave just before the arena parking lot is available for public use.



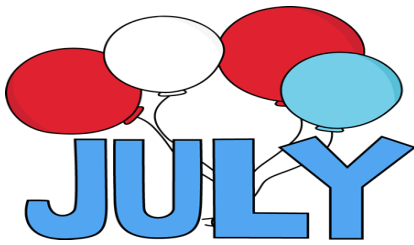
Operation of Off-Highway Vehicles – Direct Route in and Out of the Village

Residents are reminded that operation of Off-Highway Vehicles (OHV) including ATV's and trail bikes are not permitted in the Village of Clive except for direct routes in and out of the Village and for loading and unloading. Please report suspicious activity or illegal vehicle use to the Blackfalds RCMP complaint line at 403-885-3333 noting description of vehicle, license plates and time of occurrence.

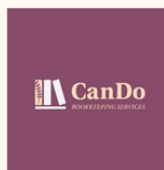
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
