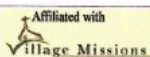

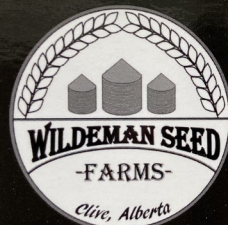

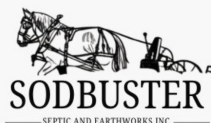

It is a day to listen, learn, and acknowledge the truths shared by Indigenous communities about the harms caused by colonial policies and practices. By recognizing this day, we take an important step toward reconciliation, building understanding, respect, and stronger relationships between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples.
